Congratulations to Dan Stuart and Abigail Maynard Finlay, who will be representing Hawaii District 5000 and going to Copenhagen, Denmark for 5 weeks starting in October.

The Group Study Exchange (GSE) program of The Rotary Foundation is a unique cultural and vocational exchange opportunity for young business and professional men and women between the ages of 25 and 40 who are in the early years of their professional lives.

Rotary districts in different countries are paired to send and receive professional study groups. Four to six non-Rotarian team members, and one Rotarian team leader, travel for four to six weeks, staying in the homes of Rotarians whenever

possible. Team members study and observe their host country's professional operations, systems of government, education, health, welfare and social institutions.

Applicants must be between 25 to 40 years old and have been employed full time for two years in a recognized profession. Team members will be selected by a district selection committee, based on applications and interviews. Applications must be endorsed by a sponsoring Rotary Club in Hawaii.

The Rotary Foundation and the respective Rotary Districts fund the GSE Team. Rotary International is made up of more than 31,000 Rotary Clubs located in 200 countries and geographical regions throughout the world. In Hawaii, there are more than 2,200 members in 42 Rotary Clubs state wide which make up Rotary District 5000.
